- **Personality of the month:** **Ahmed Ebrahim Haroon Jaffer** (1909 - 1990.), Pakistani businessman, legislator. Education: Anglo-Urdu High School & Deccan Coll, Poona; married Maryam d/o late Sait Haji Ebrahim Ismail of Belgaum and Bangalore. Mem Indian Legis Assem, 1934 (Bombay Cent Div MR); and ML mem 1946 (Bombay). Migrated to Pakistan in 1947/48.
